How to Play LOTTO COMBO



LOTTO COMBO

You can play Lotto Combo with friends, family or your workmates.

The more numbers you play the more chances you have to win! Just combine everyone's lucky numbers and be in to win multiple prizes. Instead of just choosing 6 numbers you can choose 8, 9, or 10 numbers and a Lotto Combo ticket gives you every possible combination of those numbers. Because you are playing with more combinations of numbers you could win more prizes!

HOW DO I PLAY?

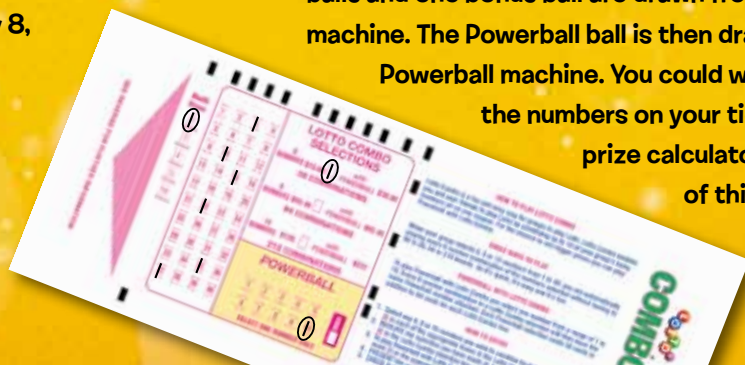
To play Lotto Combo you can either pick your own numbers by filling out a self select coupon or you can play a Combo Dip, where the computer will randomly select your numbers for you.

You can play your own number selection, or a Combo Dip, for up to 10 consecutive draws by buying a multi-draw ticket.

PICK YOUR OWN NUMBERS

To choose your own numbers mark any 8, 9 or 10 numbers from 1-40 on a Lotto Combo self select coupon.

You can also play Powerball with Lotto Combo by simply selecting one Powerball number from 1 - 10 on a Lotto Combo self select coupon.



COMBO DIPS

Ask the sales person for a Lotto Combo 8, 9, or 10 Dip. The computer will randomly select your numbers for you.

HOW DOES THE DRAW WORK?

Every Saturday night on TV2 at 8.00 pm six Lotto balls and one bonus ball are drawn from the Lotto ball machine. The Powerball ball is then drawn from the Powerball machine. You could win by matching the numbers on your ticket as per the prize calculator on the reverse of this brochure.

Watch the Lotto draw live on TV2 at 8.00 pm Saturday night. Official results are also available at your Lotto Shop, in many New Zealand newspapers, on teletext, by phoning 0900 90 900 (calls cost 99c per minute) or by visiting www.mylotto.co.nz.

WINNING WHEEL

Every Lotto ticket has a serial number. Each week one serial number is randomly drawn. The holder of the ticket with the winning serial number is invited to appear on the live Lotto draw to spin the Winning Wheel. The Winning Wheel contains both cash and non-cash prizes with values from \$100,000 up to one top prize of \$1 million.

If you do not wish to appear on the live Lotto draw you can choose to take a guaranteed \$25,000, or nominate someone to appear and spin the Winning Wheel for you.
